

TOURIST ROAD OF the IROISE COUNTRY AND THE ABERS WEDNESDAY JULY 6^{TH} - AFTERNOON

14h00: Departure from Brest to the Pays d'Iroise, the Saint Mathieu lighthouse will bring you into the past of a land which has always been linked to the sea. Then, you will use the touristic road of Iroise. In Iroise, all villages always keep an eye on the sea. The Iroise sea is the junction of the English Channel and the Atlantic Ocean.

Then, you will follow the touristic road of the Abers: Aber Ildut, Aber Benoît, Aber Wrac'h. Behind these names are hiding coastal rivers. Their mouths are little bays which are typical of Northern Brittany landscapes. The coastline is a little paradise for strollers. Arrival to Brest around 17h.
